

Information Technologist

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Performs information systems and/or information technology tasks within more than one discipline. Disciplines may include, but are not limited to, application support, database administration, software quality assurance/quality control, software engineering, network telecommunications, and infrastructure operations of administration, analysis, engineering and design. Incumbent monitors and supports the information technology and systems infrastructures. Troubleshoots and resolves basic problems. Implements various applications. Conducts basic analysis including planning, designing, and evaluating a variety of information technology tools. Responds to user requests for system needs and upgrades. Applies standard methodology, techniques, procedures and criteria. If duties in one discipline encompass more than half the time, incumbent should be matched to the job specific to that discipline and not to this generalist position.

EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING: Bachelors Degree in Computer Science, a related field or equivalent experience. A minimum of two years related experience in multiple disciplines of the information systems and technology fields.
